- Complete required reports and documentation.

- Valid Michigan Commercial Driver's License (CDL) with "S" (School Bus) and "P" (Passenger) endorsements.

- Ability to pass a background check and physical examination.
- Dependability and flexibility to respond to calls on short notice.
